

# UKSCA Community and Facility Development Grants Application Form 2017

In line with the UKSCA aims, this grant is for projects looking to promote and disseminate S&C knowledge and good practice. Applications are welcome to support a range of UK based projects;

- Promotion of S&C initiatives (sports performance, physical activity, movement coaching)
- The development of community and/or outreach projects
- The development of S&C in education, youth and amateur sports participation
- Support for S&C development through the purchase of equipment

Awards of up to £5000 are available, collaborations with organisations and institutions for match funding are strongly encouraged when applying for this grant.

## RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. Please email completed nomination forms to [grants@uksca.org.uk](mailto:grants@uksca.org.uk) by 21 July 2017 to be considered at the August grants meeting. Any applications after this date will be considered at the February 2018 meeting.
2. The grants are open to all Associate and Accredited members of the UKSCA for projects that are based in the UK and the three Crown Dependencies ie Isle of Man and the Bailiwicks of Jersey and Guernsey.
3. The project must be endorsed by an Accredited member, either as a team member or in a supervisory capacity.
4. Project leads will need to outline a strong rationale, time scale, a breakdown of how the money will be spent and how the success of the project will be measured.
5. The lead applicant will be required to update the UKSCA Grants Panel on their progress at agreed time points throughout the project and on completion.
6. Each project will have an individual set of criteria agreed by the project team and the Grants Panel.
7. Successful applicants will also be required to communicate the projects findings or achievements in the UKSCA journal.
8. All applications will be notified if they are/aren't successful 4 weeks after the panel meeting in February.
9. The Grants Panel members are not eligible for these awards.
10. The Grants Panel's decision is final.
